SUBJECT: Adoption of a policy and procedure regarding alternative dispute resolution ("ADR").

PURPOSE: To adopt a standard policy and procedure to be followed for ADR.

AUTHORITY: The Declaration, Articles and Bylaws of the Association and Colorado law.

RESOLUTION: The Board of Directors, on behalf of the Association, hereby adopts the following Policy and Procedure:


1. General Policy. In the event of any dispute involving the Association and an Owner, the Owner is invited and encouraged to meet with the Board to resolve the dispute informally and without the need for litigation. If the Owner requests to meet with the Board, the Board shall make a reasonable effort to comply with the Owner's request. Nothing in this Policy shall be construed to require any specific form of alternative dispute resolution, such as mediation or arbitration, or require the parties to meet.
2. No Waiver. Neither the Association nor the Owner waives any right to pursue whatever legal or other remedial actions available to either party.
3. Supplement to Law. The provisions of this Resolution shall be in addition to and in supplement of the terms and provisions of the Declaration and the law of the State of Colorado governing the Community.
4. Amendment. This Policy may be amended from time to time by the Board of Directors.
