2011 SWIMMING POOL RULES
FROM THE RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Stone Canyon Pool is for use of the RESIDENTS of Stone Canyon. Rules are to ensure your safety and enjoyment and to protect your property values. The following rules and regulations apply to all residents and their guests. Any abuses to the rules and regulations may result in deactivation and loss of your pool access card. If you lose your access card, a replacement fee of \$50 will be charged. The old access card number will be deactivated.

1. Pool is for use of Stone Canyon residents only who have a pool access card.
2. Hours: 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.
3. **NO LIFE GUARD ON DUTY/SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK**
A lifeguard is NOT on duty. All persons shall swim at their own risk. Residents are solely responsible for themselves, their families and their guests. The Association assumes no responsibility for any accident or injury occurring or sustained in connection with the use of the pool area.
4. Guests must be accompanied by a resident. Pool parties which exceed ten guests must have prior permission of Board or Management Company.
5. Pets are not allowed in the pool area.
6. No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.
7. No food shall be allowed in the pool or on the concrete deck surrounding the pool except for approved pool parties.
8. Persons under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
9. Pool gate must be kept locked at all times. **DO NOT PROP POOL GATE OPEN!**
10. Swim wear only allowed in pool - no cutoffs, etc. Babies must wear swim diapers.
11. Changing facilities are located adjacent to the swimming pool. The Association shall not be liable for items left unattended in these facilities.
12. NO running, jumping, horseplay, pushing, spitting, obscene language, splashing, etc. in the pool area.
13. Pool floatables must not exceed standard single person air mattress size.
14. NO radios, tape players, or barbeques are allowed in pool area, except for pool parties having Board or Management Company approval (excluding walkman's, etc).
15. No individual or group of individuals may prohibit any other use from the legitimate use of the pool. No games activities are permitted in the pool which would deprive or prevent any part of the pool from being used by all residents.
