When the time comes to stain your fence, please be aware that the accepted community standard is that all fences that are dingy or stained must be power washed or sanded prior to being stained. It is not acceptable to put fresh stain on a weathered looking fence without first power washing. Overall appearance of the fence should be evened out and cleaned. Fences should *NEVER* be painted. This list is specific to brand and color. If you wish to use a different product or color, submit a sample along with a Design Review Request prior to staining the fence.
